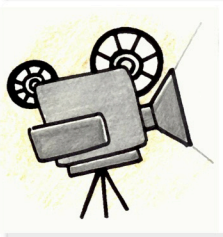


History Of Music Videos

1920

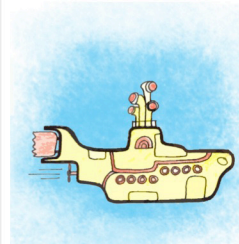
- 'Talkies' were produced.

1960



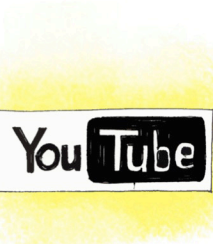
- The Beatles introduced Psychedelic music videos- 'Strawberry Fields' & 'Penny Love'.
