He got an idea,

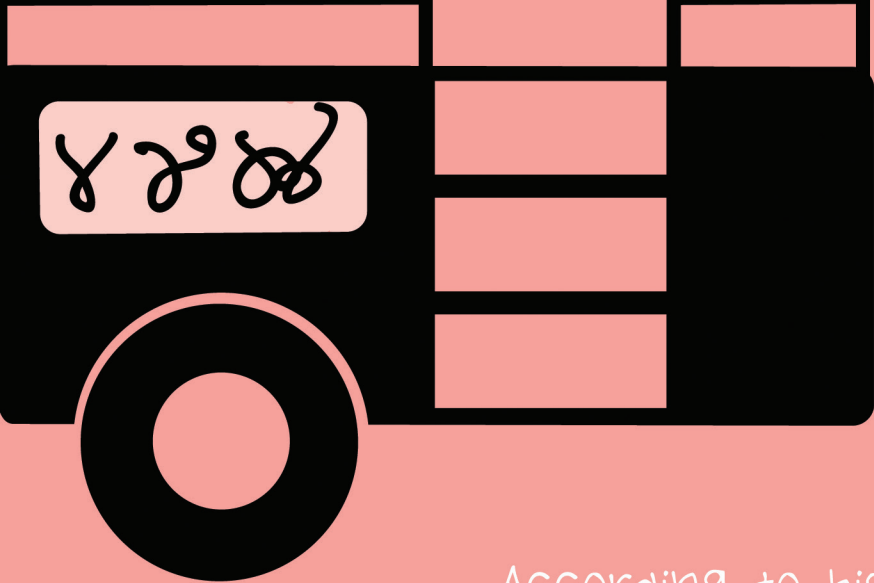
why can't he eat from outside today.

"It's a pleasant Sunday"



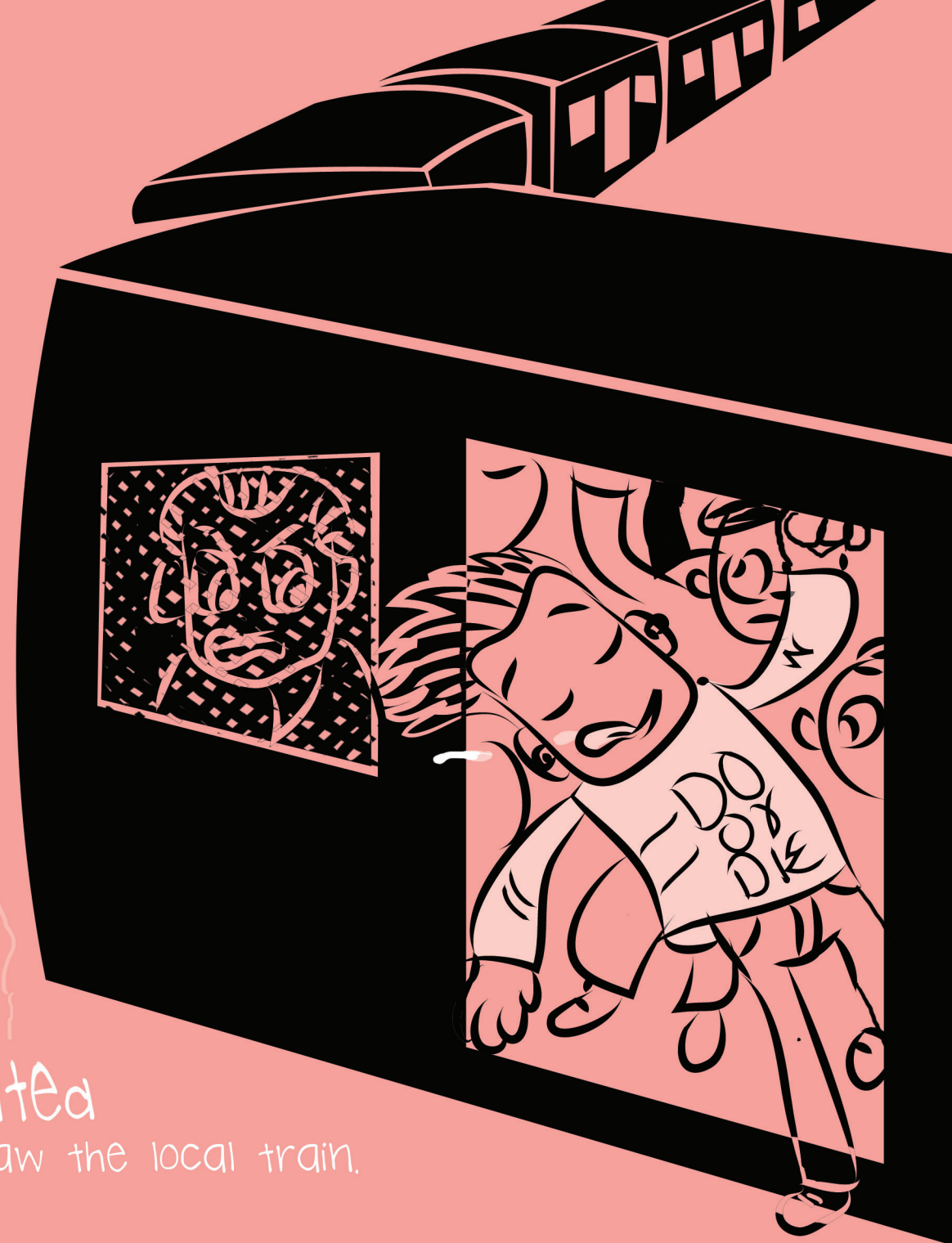


According to his friend's opinion

like worms.



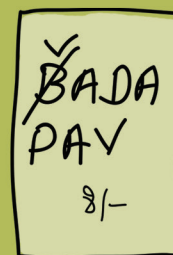
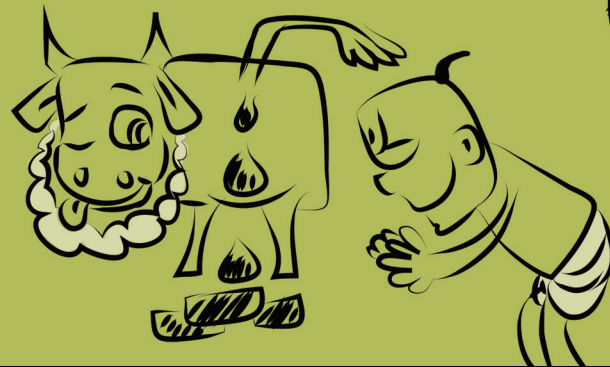
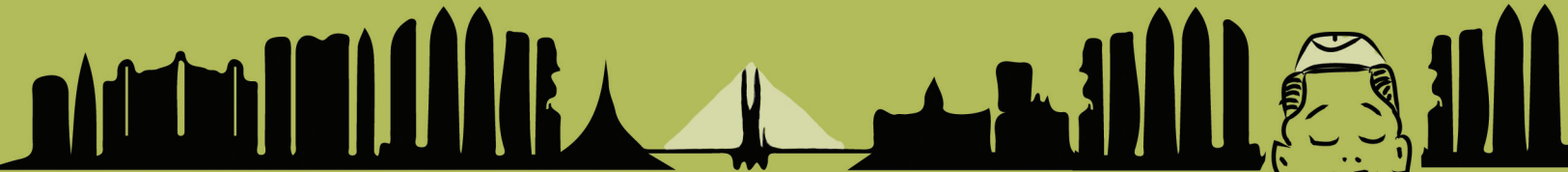
His life

Finally he decided to go by Auto

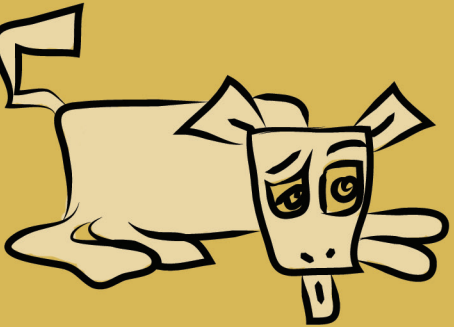
OH Mumbai !!.....

it was named "Clean land ???!! "

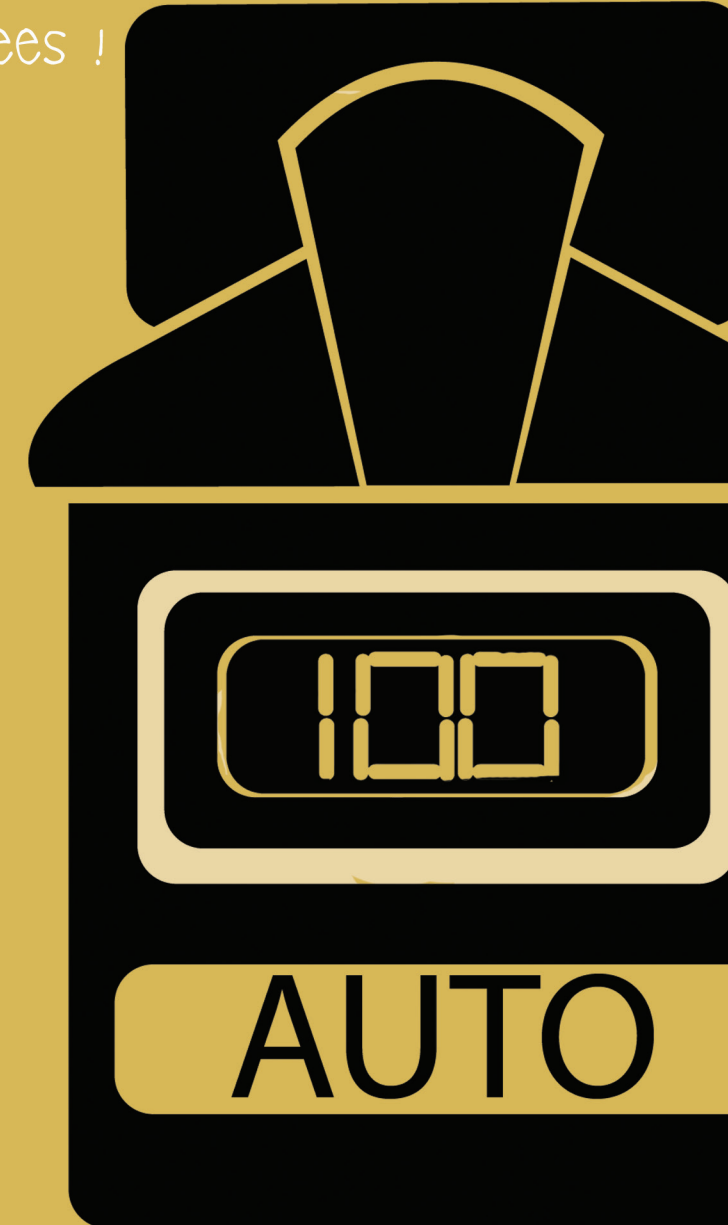


The auto metre showed 100 rupees !

while he was travelling.

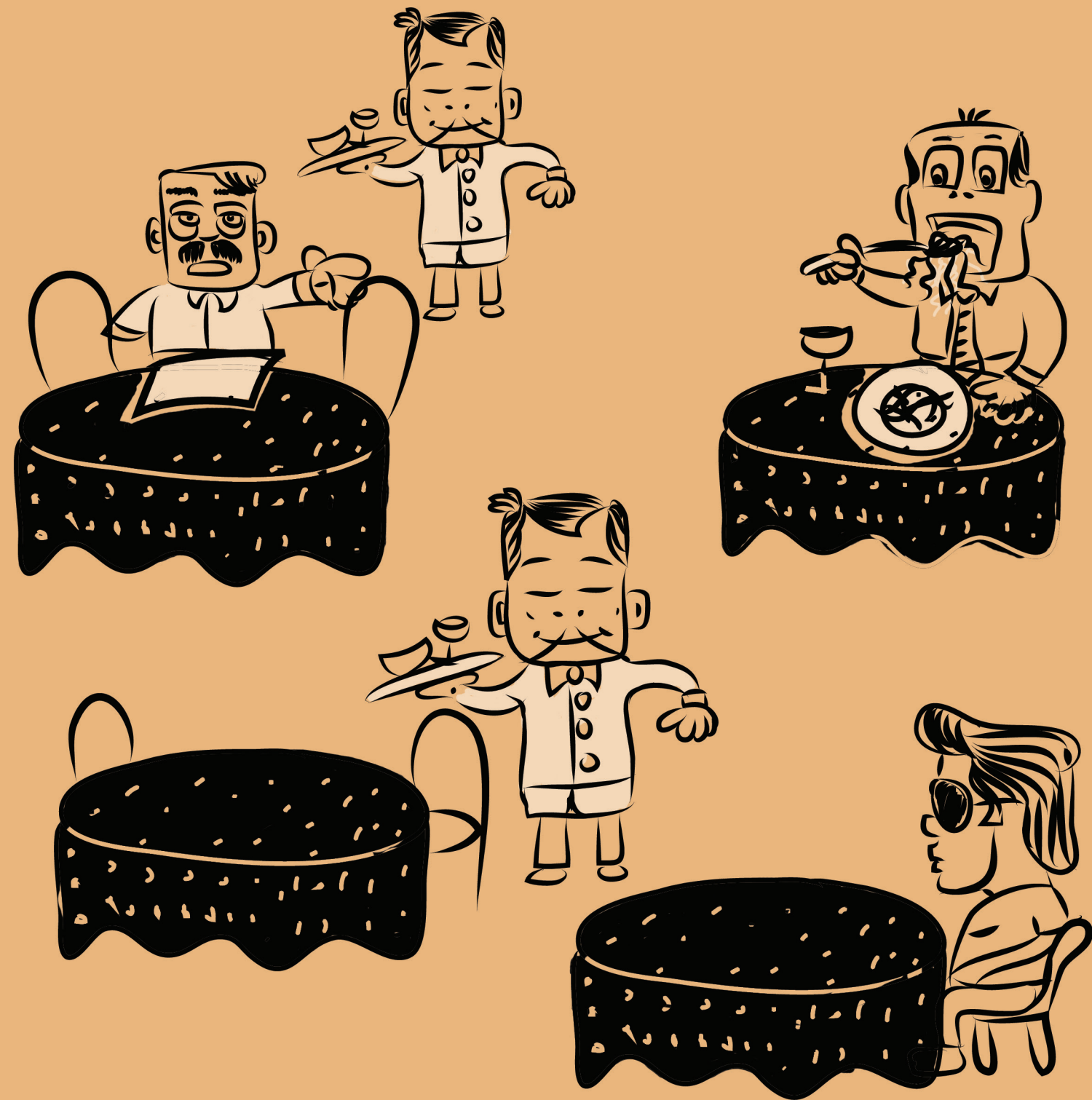
Now he had only 200 rupees

he had.

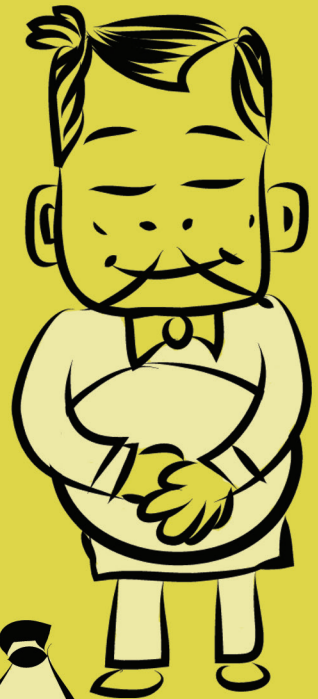
And he ordered it

he said " it's not working, sir".

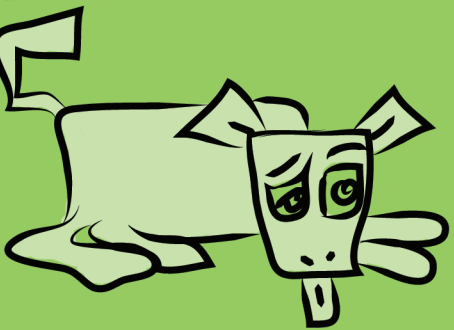


He gave the second ATM card and

the minimum balance paid the bill.

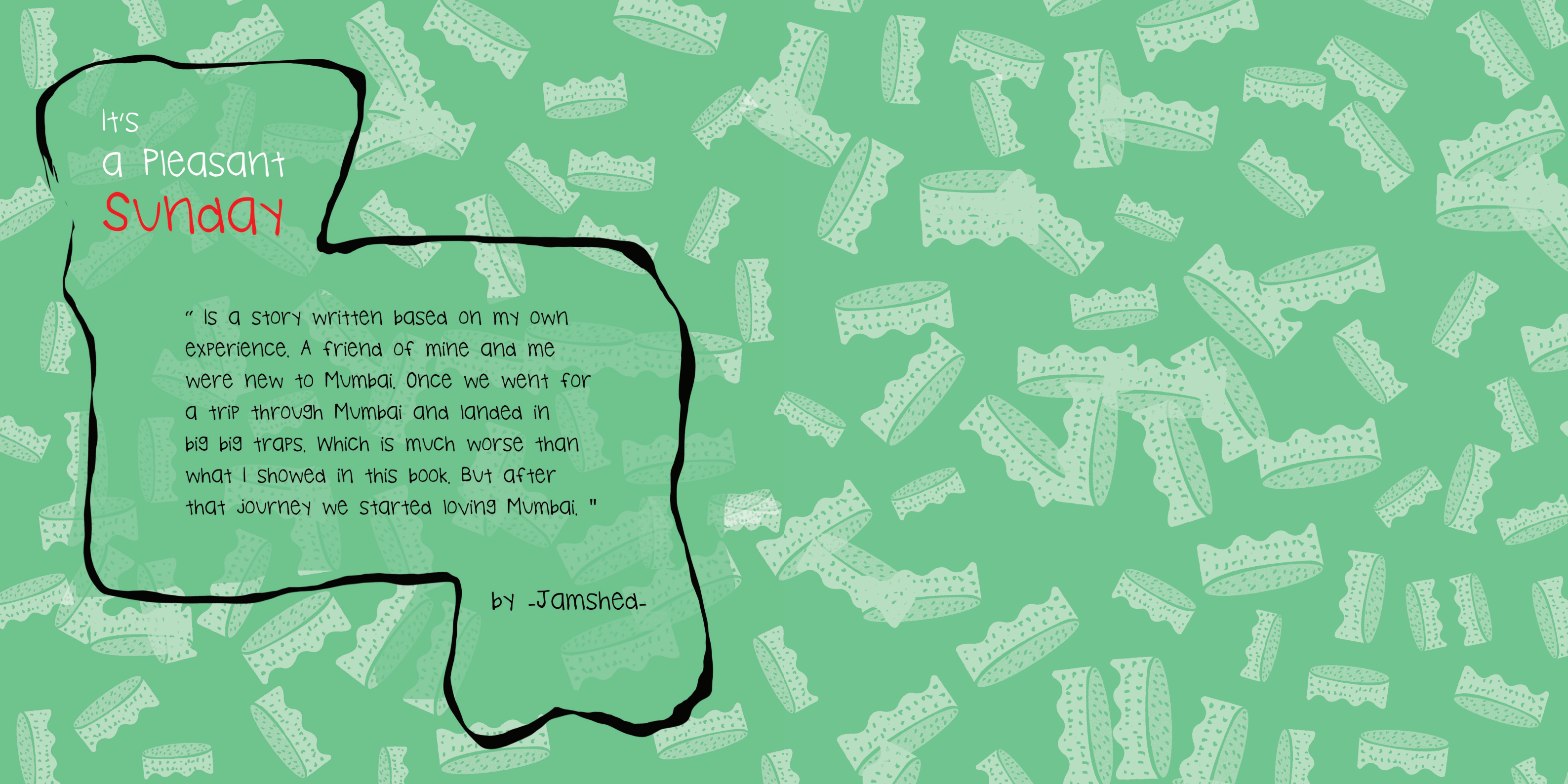


He stood in the same spot like one hour before
