- 1. Tends to mimic the toys Roleplay
- 2. Child can learn/ adopt the way of living / lifestyle Roleplay
- 3. Role play: camera, mobile, car etc. Roleplay
- 4. Toy materials can be unsafe Safety
- 5. Providing proper safety of the kid is very important for parents to decision about buying Safety
- 6. Kids should approach the toy by themselves Approach
- 7. New toy should be familiar with usability or friendly to approach Approach
- 8. It should provide curiosity at each stage Curiosity
- 9. Exploration: wants to poke, prod and rip things. Pick up things using their thumb and pointer fingers Curiosity
- 10. They are very curious Curiosity
- 11. Should be fun, maybe transformable shouldn't be monotonous Experience
- 12. Personalize experience Experience
- 13. Textures and sensations: fascinated by different texture also sensation Eg: rattle toy Sensory development
- 14. Relation of physical movement with sounds. (understanding of harmony and rhythm) Sensory development
- 15. Physical, cognitive, and social development development
- 16. Should aid the physical, and mental development of the kid development
- 17. Responds to child by dramatic formal play.(Sense of communication with child.) Interaction
- 18. Dramatic Interaction
- 19. Feedback Interaction
- 20. Smell and taste in terms of childhood memories Memories
- 21. Open ended toys are better to develop creativity
- 22. The toy should be able to withstand wear and tear

Insights:

Must have

- The toy should be safe for the kids form, material and size of parts, etc.
- The toy should be easy to operate and visually approachable.
- The toy should be able to withstand wear and tear

May have

- The toy should be relatable to their surrounding environment
- The toy should be able to keep up with the curiosity of the kid
- The toy should facilitate the physical development of the kid like sensory, fine motor and gross motor skills
- The toy should facilitate the Cognitive development of the kid like logical, creative and linguistic skills.
- The toy should facilitate the social development of the kid like emotional, communication, self- esteem, empathy etc.
- The toy should communicate with the child.
- The toy should be able to create memories
- The toy should be more open ended.
- The toy should provide a personalised experience to the kid
